Extension Explanation of Fees

Application Fee – This non-refundable fee must accompany a student’s application for admission. It serves to cover the cost of processing applicants.

Re-enrollment Fee – covers the costs of processing current students

Book Fee – This fee covers the cost of textbook rental and student activity books and does not apply to special course supplies. Any correspondence/PACE courses which may be necessary for graduation will be charged to the student’s account.

Tuition – Tuition covers the general cost of operating the school. Unless paid in full, tuition is billed monthly on a 12-month or a 10-month schedule with the FACTS Tuition Management program. If you ever have a problem meeting your payment schedule, please call the school office.

NYACS Fee—covers the membership fee for the New York Association of Christian Schools

Standardized Testing Fee – covers the cost of the achievement tests given in April to evaluate and measure a student’s progress in meeting content standards.

Nondiscriminatory Policy

Emmanuel Baptist Academy admits students of any cultural affiliation or national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, and admissions, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school-administrated programs.

Specialty Fees

Specialty fees are fees not covered by the normal tuition. Specialty fees include individual music lessons, some band and specialty music group fees, athletic participation fees, entrance tests, graduation fee, fine arts competition, and various field trips.

General Information

1. Any check returned to our school office because of insufficient funds will be charged a \$30 fee.
2. Any student who attends a portion of a semester is responsible to pay the tuition and fees for the entire semester. This amount will be adjusted if a student must leave due to a move out of the area or the loss of a parent’s job. Fees will be pro-rated for students who enroll after the start of a semester.
3. If a family ever has a financial problem or question, contact our school office. Our goal is to work with you and for you.

Extension Dress Code Policy

As a Christian educational institution, Emmanuel Baptist Academy (Emmanuel Baptist Academy Home School Extension) believes that its responsibility before God is to maintain a testimony honoring to the Lord in every aspect of life. Christian education is designed to instruct children and youth in proper attitudes and patterns of living. This necessarily includes manner of dress and general appearance.

School dress is to be worn to and from school unless prior permission has been granted by the Assistant Administrator.

Boys:

Boys are to be dressed neatly and conservatively and be well-groomed at all times. With the exception of rings, watches and medical identification, jewelry is not to be worn. Boys may wear button-down dress shirts, collared pullover shirts, unmarked tee shirts, or turtlenecks. Dress or casual shoes with socks must be worn. Dress or casual pants (including dark, undecorated jeans) must be modest, clean and neat. Clothing which is faded or obviously worn is not permissible. Belts must be worn with pants that are so designed. This produces a pleasing, finished look which reflects the high standard set for those representing Christ and Homeschool Support Services. Hair styles must also be of modest appearance. Hair must be cut so that it is above the eyebrows, ears and shirt collar. Hair must be tapered to avoid a ragged look. Sideburns must not extend past the middle of the ear. Beards and mustaches are not permissible.

Girls:

Girls are to be dressed neatly and conservatively, and be well-groomed at all times. Modest styles of dresses and skirts as well as dress or casual pants (including dark, undecorated jeans) are permissible. Dress or casual pants must be modest-fitting, clean and neat. Clothing which is faded or obviously worn is not permissible. Necklines on dresses, shirts and/or blouses must not be low. Dress and skirt lengths must be to the middle of the knee or longer. Slits and other separations must not extend beyond the middle of the knee. Christian modesty dictates that tight-fitting, see-through, or low-cut clothing is not appropriate. Hair should be kept away from eyes.

Proper athletic attire must be worn for all physical education classes. Shorts must be within three inches of the knee in length. Shirts must have sleeves and be long enough to guard modesty during regular physical activity. Athletic shoes and socks must be worn during physical education classes and sports activities unless otherwise directed by the instructor.

It is the desire of Emmanuel Baptist Academy (Emmanuel Baptist Academy Home School Extension) that apparel be complimentary to the student and properly reflective of biblical standards. The key is to exercise good taste, judgment and discretion at all times.

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Parent Cooperation Agreement

We value the love and support of our school families, and we desire to establish and maintain a good relationship with them. No two people will agree on everything. No organization is perfect, no matter how sincere the leadership. Still there must be a basic unity of direction and a strong mutual trust for people to work together in a task as vital as the training of children.

This agreement form addresses some areas that are important in maintaining that unity and trust.

Please read carefully. If you feel you cannot sign this agreement with a supportive spirit, please contact Mrs. Woudenberg so your concerns can be addressed.

In enrolling or returning our child(ren) to Emmanuel Baptist Academy (EBA) for the _____ school year, I (we) understand the following:

1. We are accepting the challenge to help “bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord” and state that this training will be carried on in the home. We place our trust in EBA to assist us in that training.
2. We will show sincere Christian purpose by the faithful and regular attendance of ourselves (at least one parent) and our children to a Bible-believing church.
3. We will support the school by faithfully praying for its program and staff and will support the procedures and disciplinary actions of the school in fact and in spirit.
4. We will attempt to promote the spirit of unity within the ministry of the school by following the Matthew 18 principle. That is, we agree that if we have a problem related to the school, we will always first contact the person involved in the problem at the school (rather than those not concerned) who can best help and if necessary continue up the proper chain of authority until our problem is remedied.
5. We will speak of the school in the best light possible, even when we disagree on a particular policy or action. We will assume that the school means well, having as its goal the glory of God and the good of the students. If we no longer sincerely hold this assumption, we will transfer our child, but we will not tear down the school in the eyes of others.
6. We are investing authority in the school to discipline our child as necessary. We further agree that we will cooperate and discipline our child as needed in the home (Proverbs 13:24, 19:18, 23:13-14, 29:15,17; Colossians 3:20; Hebrews 12:6).
7. We are pledging that if, for any reason, our child does not respond favorably to the school authorities and if necessary we will quietly withdraw him.
8. We understand that our child will go on scheduled field trips and other school activities unless excused by the school authorities.

9. We are agreeing to pay all tuition and fees according to agreements, and to conclude all required payments on or before the last day of the payment schedule. If payments cannot be made when due, we will contact the school office to make arrangements. We understand that if tuition payments get behind, our child may not be able to continue in school and that report cards and records will be withheld at the end of the school year if required payments are not made in full.
10. We are acknowledging that we have read this Parent Cooperation Agreement and the Dress Code Policy, and we will uphold them both in fact and spirit.
11. We understand that the application for enrollment of our child(ren) becomes final upon receipt by the office of this signed agreement.

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Statement of Faith

1. **THE SCRIPTURES** -- We believe that the Holy Bible was written by men divinely-inspired, and is a perfect treasure of God's message, that it has God for its author, salvation for its end, and truth, without any mixture of error, for its matter.
2. **GOD THE FATHER** -- He is one and only one living and true God, an intelligent, spiritual and tri-personal Being, the Creator, Preserver and Ruler of the universe, infinite in holiness and all other perfection, to whom we owe the highest love, reverence, and obedience.
3. **GOD THE SON** -- We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ was begotten of the Holy Spirit without a human father, born of a virgin, and is truly God and truly man, that His deity is absolute, unique and singular.
4. **GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT** -- We believe the Holy Spirit is the Third Person in the Godhead, fully equal to the Father and the Son. His Old Testament ministries were limited to selective indwelling, restraint of sin, and enablement for service. His New Testament ministries include conviction, regeneration, indwelling, sealing, filling, baptism, distributing gifts and teaching. We believe the baptism of the Holy Spirit to be the placing of the believer into the body of Christ (church) at the moment of conversion (I Corinthians 12:13). We believe that some gifts of the Holy Spirit were temporary (e.g. tongues, healing, apostleship, prophecy) and that these no longer are authentic gifts of the Holy Spirit (I Corinthians 13:8)
5. **FALL OF MAN** -- We believe, according to the teachings of Scripture, that man was created a moral being in the image of God and after His likeness, but by voluntary transgression fell from his original sinless state. In consequence, the whole human race was involved in guilt, making all mankind now sinners, depraved in nature, spiritually dead and hopeless apart from divine grace.
6. **THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST** -- We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of Christ; that His body which was raised from the dead according to the Scriptures was a literal body consisting of flesh and bone.
7. **THE WAY OF SALVATION** -- We believe that salvation, according to the Scriptures, is wholly by grace through faith plus nothing.
8. **THE SECURITY OF THE BELIEVER** -- We believe that all born-again persons are eternally secure in Christ since the Scripture teaches that our justification before God rests solely upon the finished work of Christ.
9. **THE CHURCH** -- We believe that the Church, the Body of Christ, is composed of all those who have true faith in the Lord Jesus Christ; that the visible church or assembly is a congregation of baptized believers, associated by covenant in the faith, and the fellowship of the gospel, and observing the ordinances of Christ, the true Head of the Church.
10. **THE OBLIGATION OF HOLINESS** -- We believe that all believers in the Lord Jesus Christ are called into a life of separation from the World.
11. **THE EVANGELIZATION OF THE WORLD** -- We believe in the evangelization of the world, placing emphasis upon the task of reaching the individual with the gospel and its implications; and that no humanitarian and philanthropic schemes may be substituted for the preaching of the Cross.

12. BIBLE INTERPRETATION -- We believe in the literal teaching of the Word. Therefore, every declaration is to be taken in its primary, ordinary, literal and its most obvious meaning unless the facts of the context and the well-defined laws of language clearly indicate the terms to be symbolic or figurative, and not literal.
13. CREATION -- We believe in the Genesis account of creation which teaches that all things found their origin in God who created by His own hand instantaneously every living thing after its kind.
14. THE RETURN OF CHRIST -- We believe, according to the Scriptures, in the sure return of the Lord Jesus Christ; that His second coming will be a literal, bodily, personal return; that His coming for His Bride, the Church, constitutes the "Blessed Hope" set before us, for which we should be constantly looking. We believe that His coming will be pretribulational and premillennial.
15. SATAN -- We believe in a literal Hell and the reality of the person of Satan, "that old serpent, called the devil and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world."
